

Progressing to the Next Level

How students progress to the next level

- Pass the final test (the pass mark is 65%).
- If you don't pass the final test, you can still go to the next level if:
 - you have only one 'needs more work' mark in your latest continuous assessment;
 - your attendance is good (85%+);
 - you have good marks in your other tests (65%+)

Why students continue at the same level

- Fail the final test and:
 - your latest continuous assessment scores are low (below target in two areas);
 - you have low test scores.

Students who fail to take the final test

Students who do not take the final test can progress to the next level provided they have a good reason for missing the test and they meet the criteria above for students who do not get 65% in the final test.

Who can study on a 10 week IELTS course:

- Students who pass the intermediate level in the school;
- Students whose placement test is Upper-Intermediate;
- Students who have an IELTS certificate with an overall score of 5.

Free IELTS classes

- Students can study on the free IELTS course if they are currently in a pre-intermediate or intermediate class.

Free FCE classes

- Students can study on the free FCE course if they are currently in an intermediate or upper-intermediate class.
